5 Categories of English letter pronunciation:

1. /ee/: B, C, D, E, G, P, T, V, Z

B - /bee/, C - /see/, D - /dee/, E - /ee/, G - /jee/, P - /pee/, T - /tee/, V - /vee/, Z - /zee/

2. /e/: F, L, M, N, S, X

F - /ef/, L - /el/, M - /em/, N - /en/, S - /es/, X - /eks/

3. /A/: A, H, J, K

A - /A/, H - /Ach/, J - /jA/, K - /kA/

4. /yoo/: Q, U, W

Q - /kyoo/, U - /yoo/, W - /duhbulyoo/

5. /I/: I, Y

I - /I/, Y - /wI/
